A strong working knowledge of programming languages, specifically Java & JavaScript is essential and familiarity with major front end testing frameworks including Playwright, and Cypress is preferable.

- Work closely with a Senior Automation Engineer to assist with the design, development and maintenance of automated functional and non-functional test frameworks and suites.
- Leverage observability tools to analyse production behaviour and analyse traffic patterns
- Identify, advocate for and deliver automation improvements across multiple delivery teams
- Identify appropriate tooling and methodology to improve overall automation coverage.
- Work closely with the development team and the business stake holders to ensure that the frameworks are well understood and provide value.
- Provide mentorship and guidance to other team members in test automation principles and best practices.
